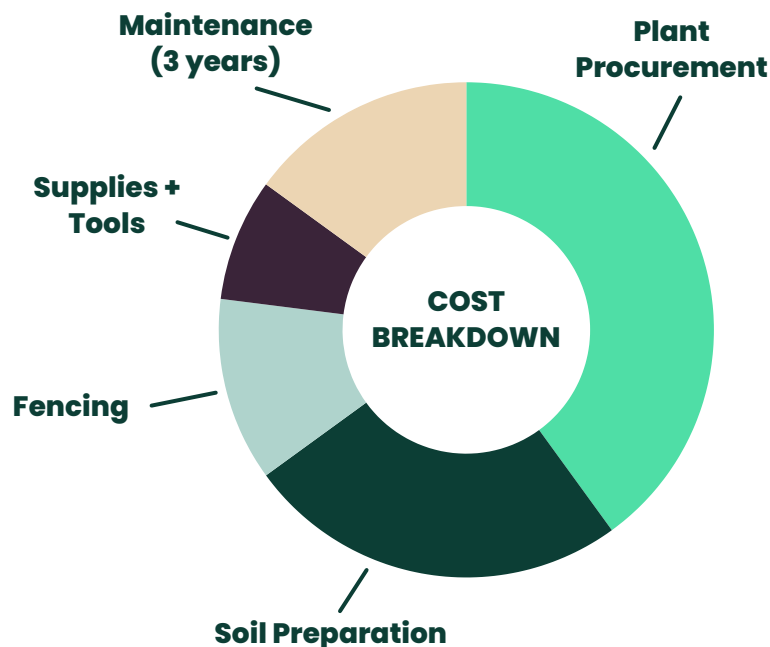

How much does a Tiny Forest Cost?

Creating a Tiny Forest takes both financial and community support to make it a reality. Whether through existing financial support or in-kind contributions like planning and fundraising, your involvement helps make it happen.

The cost of a Tiny Forest varies drastically based on the size, site conditions, and the amount of in-kind support. On average, a Tiny Forest will cost \$100-\$200 per square metre.



Where does funding come from?

GRANTS

1 City of Ottawa - Community Environmental Projects Grant Program

Provides funding to community groups and non-profit organizations interested in undertaking small-scale, community-based initiatives that support an environmentally sustainable Ottawa.

2 Tree Canada Treemendous Communities Grant

Supports community groups and non-profit organizations in community tree planting projects.

3 South Nation Conservation Authority Community Environmental Grant

Provides funding to Non-Profit organizations, community groups and municipalities for plantings or community events.
